OUAD Tech Forum

Dr. Virginia B. Watson was part of the U.S. delegation in the "QUAD Critical and Emerging Technology Forum" held at the University of Tokyo in Tokyo, Japan on August 19-21, 2024. This meeting of representatives from the private and public sector of each Quad state (Australia, India, Japan, and the U.S.) is a follow-up to a first one that was held in August 2023 in the U.S. The purpose of the forum was to further narrow recommendations on ways that Quad cooperation in technology can be further advanced. Dr. Watson served both as moderator for one of the forum's sessions, "Opportunities to progress domain awareness" and one of three breakout groups on "Advancing Indo-Pacific Technology-related Infrastructure, Partnerships, and Narratives/Communications." She was also a discussant in a panel that shared the forum's findings to a gathering of University of Tokyo faculty and students, diplomats, and the public at large on the final day of the event. The forum was co-organized by the Near East South Asia Center for Strategic Studies (NESA - USA) with the host institution - Research Center
